

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ARANSAS PASS, TEXAS AMENDING A PORTION OF STREET NAME TO CHANGE FROM ALLEN BOULEVARD TO BILL HAINES WAY AT THE INTERSECTION OF TURNBOUGH AVENUE AND ALLEN BOULEVARD UP TO THE SOUTH OF CONN BROWN HARBOR PARKING LOT, AS SHOWN IN (EXHIBIT A&B), BEING APPROXIMATELY 2,421.3 FEET STRETCH OF ROAD IN ARANSAS PASS, TX,

WHEREAS, the request by City of Aransas Pass to rename a portion of Allen Boulevard to Bill Haines Way at the intersection of Turnbough Avenue and Allen Boulevard up to south of Conn Brown Harbor parking lot, being approximately 2,421.3 feet stretch of road, in Aransas Pass, TX.

WHEREAS, proper procedures of Article II, Section 26-29-Procedure for renaming or changing names of Streets were followed with proper notice to the public, hereinafter described was considered at a public hearing on Monday, February 8, 2021, during a meeting of Planning and Zoning Commission, recommended denial.

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on the 15th day of February, 2021 to consider the request, and action was taken to overturn the Planning and Zoning Commission recommendation, or to approve the request.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aransas Pass, Texas, that a portion of Allen Boulevard be renamed as described; to-wit:

BILL HAINES WAY: AT THE INTERSECTION OF TURNBOUGH AVENUE AND ALLEN BOULEVARD UP TO THE ENTRANCE OF CONN BROWN HARBOR PARKING LOT, IN ARANSAS PASS, TX.

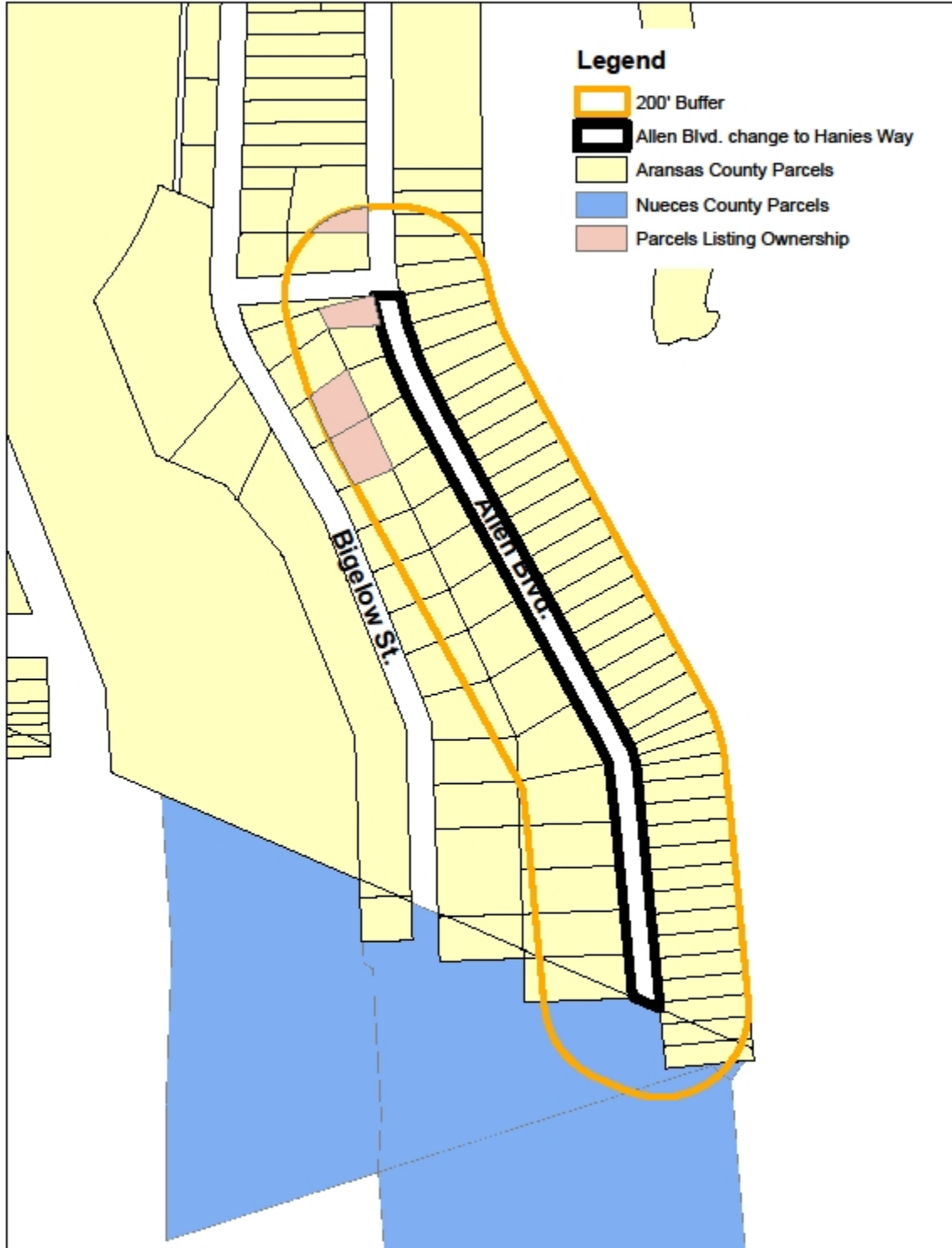
